

UNDERSTANDING FLUTD / LUTD

Feline Lower Urinary Tract Disease (FLUTD) in cats and Lower Urinary Tract Disease (LUTD) in dogs are general terms for various inflammatory diseases, infections, and other conditions affecting the urinary tract. Sometimes FLUTD and LUTD are caused by bladder stones. Struvite and calcium oxalate are common types. In cats, Feline Idiopathic Cystitis (FIC) is the most common type of FLUTD.
